### FALL SEASON IS SET

Hope those soccer cleats have dried out from the spring, because believe it or not, the fall season is right around the corner for our in-town program. The dates are set and coaches should be contacting players and families no later than **Sept. 4**. Here's the scoop:



**INSTRUCTIONAL:** The instructional program is a fun, recreational program for our youngest soccer players, which begins on **Saturday, Sept. 9**. The program is designed to provide the players with an outdoor activity and to introduce them to soccer through a variety of fun games.

- ⚽ Sessions run from 9:15-10:15 a.m. and 10:30-11:30 a.m. each Saturday.
- ⚽ Shinguards are mandatory, cleats are optional but suggested. A size 3 ball is used.
- ⚽ A t-shirt/jersey is issued to all new players.

**MICRO:** The micro program is designed to be a fun and recreational program for children 5 and 6 years old (Kindergarten and first grade usually). **Games will begin on Sunday, Sept. 10**. The children play in a 4v4 format to allow many touches on the ball. Children play both offense and defense with no goalkeeping.

- ⚽ Games are played on Sunday afternoons.
- ⚽ In addition, there is one practice each week.
- ⚽ Shinguards are mandatory, cleats are optional but suggested. A size 3 ball is used.
- ⚽ A t-shirt/jersey is issued to all new players.

**INTRAMURAL:** The intramural program is a fun, recreational program for children 7 and 8 years old (second and third grades usually) and is played in a 6v6 format. Basic FIFA rules are followed. **Games will begin on Sunday, Sept. 10**.

- ⚽ In addition, there is one practice each week.
- ⚽ Shinguards are mandatory, cleats are optional but suggested. A size 4 ball is used.
- ⚽ A reversible MYS jersey is issued to all new players.
